# Will the Two Witnesses Rebuild the Temple?

When the Bride leaves, we know the Two Witnesses of Rev 11, are revealed to Israel. Their message it is to be authenticated by supernatural signs and wonders performed by these two prophets. Their mission is to gather up the 144,000 Jewish remnant unto Christ. 8 Above when he said, Sacrifice and offering and burnt offerings and [offering] for sin thou wouldest not, neither hadst pleasure [therein]; which are offered by the law;

10 By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once [for all].

As a minister of the Gospel I can't see one thing left but the going of the Bride. And the Bride has to be taken away before they could recognize what's happened. They were bound, scattered--I mean, they were scattered, blinded, and now gathered. What's left? The Bride to be taken out of the way, waiting for the going of her Bride, so their prophets of Revelations 11 can call them to the Feast of the Trumpet, to make them to recognize what they have done.

### Recognize what they have done

40-1 REVELATION.OF.JESUS.CHRIST - CHURCH.AGE.BOOK.CPT.1 Little Benjamin typifies the 144,000 Israelites from all over the earth who have gone back to Palestine for their redemption. They will be standing there ready to receive Him, Whom to know aright is Life eternal. They will say, "This is our God for Whom we have waited." Then they will see Him Whom they have pierced. And they will cry out in dismay, "Where did these awful wounds come from? How did it happen?" And they will wail and cry, every family apart, everyone apart in the agony of sorrow.

Now, watch. They had in their blindness martyred their Messiah, and now they were reaping for it. They realized it. They recognized after it was gone on. They seen then when they come before the altar of God. But now the grace of God is to them.

Now, watch. Now, they could not, by no means, be saints, 'cause they would already be robed, but here they are now, just souls under the altar for the Word of God and the testimony they held for being God's people, the Jews. But now, watch.

He made hisself known there by the altar, his own altar, in his palace, his throne; he said, "Everybody leave me." His wife was over in the palace where the Bride will be. And he said to them; he said, "Don't you know me?" Hey, he's speaking in Hebrew now. "I'm your brother, Joseph." Oh, my.

They said, "Now, oh, you're going to get us."

Said, "Wait a minute; wait a minute. God did that for a purpose, had you to throw me out in order to save life." Glory, there you are exactly. He said, "Don't--don't be angry with yourself." Remember Joseph said that? He said, "Don't be angry with yourself. Everything's all right now. It's all over. God sent me here ahead of you."

You know, the Bible said they'll say to Him when they see Him coming, said, "Say, You're the Messiah, we know; but--but what about them scars?" See? He said, "Oh, I got them in the house of My friends."

Friends, and then they'll, when they realize it, them that's left, the hundred and forty-four thousand, the Bible said that they'll separate one house from the other one and take days just to cry and wail and walk up and down the floor, saying, "How did we do it? How did we do it? Why, we crucified our own Messiah." They crying like a home would for its only begotten son. "How did we do it?"

And the true Seed of David will take the throne, which is Jesus Christ, and there will reign over the Church as His Bride, in the house with Him and over the twelve tribes of Israel throughout all eternity.

And these little places... As David could not build the true tabernacle of God, because he wasn't prepared to do it... There was nothing he could do. He was a mortal and shed blood.

So is it today to us. We are not prepared to build the true Tabernacle of God. There's only One can do that, and it's being in its construction now. But this little tabernacle, along with the temple that Solomon built Him, and along with the others, are only temporary places of worship until the time comes when the real Tabernacle will be set up upon the earth, and righteousness shall reign from sky to sky, and there will be no more sorrow. He knowed when Solomon dedicated that temple, he prayed a prayer, and said, "God, if Thy people be in trouble anywhere and look towards this holy temple, then hear from heaven." And he believed it.

When people are being healed all around us everywhere, and we don't have to look towards the temple made with hands of men, but a temple of God where Jesus sets at the right hand, with His own Blood (Hallelujah.), a temple that can't fade away.

Now, the sixfold purpose--and we find out that on this sixth purpose, "to anoint the most Holy," we find out that most Holy always represented the church, the Tabernacle. And it came... to pass, as the trumpets and the singers were... to make one sound to be heard the praising and thanksgiving of the LORD; and when they lifted up their voices with the trumpet and the cymbals and the instruments of musick, and praising the LORD, and singing, For he is good; and his mercies endure for ever: that then the house was filled with a cloud, even the house of the LORD;

So that the priests stood--the priests could not stand to minister by reasons of the cloud: for the glory of the LORD had filled the house of God.

God came into the sanctuary that was to be anointed and was given over to Him for the people to come to worship. So to anoint not thy Holy place, but to anoint the most holy place... Now, when Zerubbabel dedicated his temple after it was rebuilt, it was not anointed again, because it was already been anointed, and been tore down, or it was just instructed again. The destruction had it--come to it. It had been instructed again and put up, so there was no anointing of it anymore. When it was one time anointed, that carried on through, and it goes on till this very time. But when God sets up the Millennium Tabernacle, He will anoint the most Holy, not thy holy, but the most Holy. But when the King takes His throne for one thousand years... Glory! She's over now. The anointing of the most Holy will be the last thing take place.

When the Tabernacle is erected, the resurrection has come, the Jews has returned, Christ and His Bride has come, the Jew--the 144,000 are sealed, the Millennium has taken place, there will be an anointing when the most Holy Place will be anointed, the Holy, holiest of holies, and the most Holy, when... The most Holy Place is a sanctuary where God lived between the Cherubim, and this time Christ will set in the most Holy Place with the anointing upon Him. And they'll need no sun there, for the Lamb in the midst of the City shall be the Light. The sun will never go down in that City, as old Uncle Jim used to say. And it never will, because Christ will be that Light, the anointed One. And the King will come and take His throne for one thousand years to reign.
